本次會議的主題將聚焦於家庭醫學相關議題，特別是近期內許多突破性的研究及隨之而來所需面對的挑戰。我們邀請許多極富盛名的醫師及學者與會發表相關演說，而且共收到國內外醫師投稿oral/poster論文摘要300多篇，相信在台北舉辦的這一場國際會議，將是千載難逢的機會，您我都不可錯過的年度盛事。

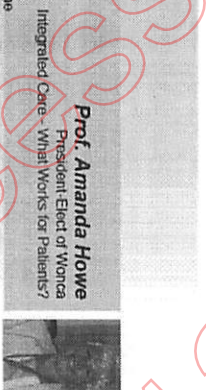

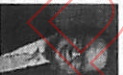

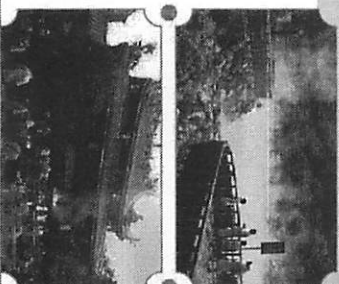
Attractions in Taipei

Lungshan Temple

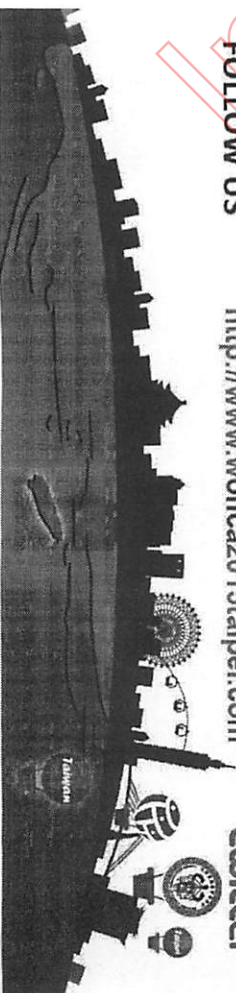
